"And The king of Egypt was told that the people had fled, and Pharaoh and his servants had a change of heart about the people, and they said, "What have we done that we have released Israel from bondage to us?" (14:15)

Rabbi Yaakov Kaminetsky marvels at the change of heart of the Egyptians, not so much its evil intent as it's sheer stupidity. What could they have been thinking? Had they sent away the Jewish people of their own free will, or had they been compelled to do so by ten plagues culminating in the death of every firstborn in the land of Egypt? What had changed now?

This then is just one more demonstration of the extraordinary power of self interest, of human desire's ability to completely overtake one's intelligence. A person can bring himself to such a state of self delusion that he forgets things he himself has seen only days before. Pharaoh was able to shut his mind to the suffering wreaked by the plagues on his kingdom; the death of his firstborn son, the tremendous outcry of anguish that had pierced the midnight air of Egypt. All was forgotten, in order to enable him to believe he had voluntarily released the Jewish people, and then to experience a change of heart.
