"Every man and woman who had the generosity of heart to contribute to all the work that G-d had commanded to be done through Moses, the children of Israel brought their donations to G-d." (35:29)

What is the significance of the seemingly repetitive phrase "the people of Israel brought their donations to G-d?"

The Chida explains that sometimes a person is inspired to make a donation to a charitable cause, but once the moment of inspiration passes, he entertains second thoughts. Perhaps he regrets having made the pledge altogether, or he loses some of his former conviction, and the will behind the gift is flawed. When the Jewish people in their great numbers made their pledges to the Mishkan, it would have been reasonable to expect that many among them had second thoughts afterwards.

But it was not so. The Torah is telling us here that the inspiration behind their original pledges remained with them all the way through the actual delivery of their donations. "The people of Israel brought their donations to G-d" - (i.e.) The people brought their original donations to G-d, just as they had been conceived at the moment of the pledge, with no change of heart whatsoever.
